**ORDER**

After screening the Plaintiff's complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, Magistrate Judge Charles H. Weigle allowed the Eighth Amendment claims against Defendants Sachdeva and Mason to go forward and recommends dismissing the claim against Defendant Bryson. (Doc. 8). The Plaintiff has not objected to the Recommendation. The Court has reviewed the Recommendation and accepts and adopts the findings, conclusions, and recommendations of the Magistrate Judge. The Recommendation is **ADOPTED** and made the order of this Court. Accordingly, the claim against Defendant Bryson is **DISMISSED without prejudice**.
